AT A GLANCE Govt. Saiha College is the one and only co-educational Degree institution within Saiha District. It has a very large Campus in the heart of Saiha Town with a number of local trees. It was established in 20.7.1978. It was affiliated to NEHU for opening P.U Arts in 1980, and B.A in 1982 respectively. B.A Honours in Pol. Science and History was also affiliated in 1985, and P.U Science in 1990 and 5 major subjects namely, Education, Sociology, English, Economics and Mizo in 1995.

The College was Registered under UGC Act in 1996, and Govt. of Mizoram upgraded to Deficit Status w.e.f. 10.5.1985 and Provincialised w.e.f. 31.1.1992. It has been Accredited with C Grade in 2014 by NAAC under UGC.

At present, P.U Classes has been abolished w.e.f. 1996 and the College has only Degree classes under Mizoram University. Govt. Saiha College has 5 Staff Quarters, and one each of main building, Administrative building, Library, Computer Room and Canteen building at the Campus. College main building and Boys Hostel buildings are under construction since 2011 with the help of DONER Ministry, Govt. of India. Women Hostel is also under construction with the help of UGC and expected to be completed soon.

ADMISSION: 1. Pass in Higher Secondary Examination conducted by any recognized Boards of the State or Central Govt. are eligible to take admission in the College. 2. All compulsory fees payable to the institution shall be paid at the

time of Admission 3. Migration Certificate should be attached by the student coming from other Board of Examination other than MBSE, Mizoram. 4. All the subjects mentioned in the subject combination can be offered on the following conditions: (a) To choose Core subject, a recommendation of the Head of the

Department concern should be attached. (b) A minimum of 40% of Marks in Higher Secondary Examination is required in the Core subject. 5. Candidate passing with Vocational Courses, the equivalence may

be decided by the College Principals. Regulations of the Semester System 1) The under Graduate Course shall consist of three Academic years with two Semester in each year. Each year shall be divided into two Semester. 2) Each semester shall carry 400 Marks and the total Marks for the

Course shall be 2400. 3) Three class tests, out of which one may be Seminar/Home Assignment are to be conducted each in Theory for continuous assessment. The average of the best two shall be considered as the Mark obtained in the continuous assessment in that paper out of 20 Marks. The rest 5 Marks may be allocated to the attendance and classroom performance of each student. 4) Duration of each class shall be 1 hour. 5) The Syllabus of each paper shall be divided into 5 units. 6) The odd Semester shall commence from mid-November till may

in each Academic year. 7) Semester Examination shall be conducted twice 10th Nov-6th Dec for odd Semester and 4th May-6th June for even Semester. 8) No candidate shall be allowed to appear in any Course more than three times (including the regular chance) in one Semester and no candidate shall be allowed to appear in any Course beyond ten Semester of his/her first admission (to complete the whole Course). 9) A candidate shall register his/her name with the University in the

First Semester itself. 10) A candidate shall be permitted to proceed from the First Semester up to Final Semester irrespective of his/her failure in any of the Semester Examination subject to the condition that the candidate shall appear for all the arrear papers of each Course (s) along with the concerned Semester Examination. 11) A candidate shall be eligible to appear in the end Semester Examination only if he/she attend a minimum of 75% of attendance as per University ordinance. 12) After completion of IV Semester a student may change his/her Core subject from

any of the Elective subject with prior permission of the HOD concerns.
